Attendance Covenant

We at the School of Transformation believe in and have experienced the synergy of “group.” We understand that each person carries something unique, and that when we come together there is a greater release of the Spirit through all these different anointings coming into union. Throughout class, we form community with one another that accelerates the momentum of what we experience. To maintain community momentum, commitment is required. You bring a piece to class that only you can bring; it cannot be replaced by anyone else in the room.

Furthermore, the School of Transformation uses a cumulative curriculum in that the classes build upon each other. Many class sessions require the foundation of previous classes for full understanding and application. **Viewing all DVDs that are presented in class is a requirement.**

However, we understand that situations arise over the course of 10 months that make attending class every week very difficult. We have aimed to tailor this school so that it is manageable for most individuals with families and other commitments, and as such we understand that occasionally these other commitments come into conflict with our school time. For this reason we have the course DVDs available to check out from the Transformation Library. We ask that you manage yourself and your circumstances appropriately to maintain your commitment to the school and your fellow students. **If you are unable to attend class more than 6 times over the course of the school year, you will not receive a certificate of completion** for successfully completing the class at the end of the year **and will therefore not be able to be considered for application for the subsequent year**^{1 2}. For example, if a student misses 7 sessions of the first year program, they would not be eligible for second year, but could reapply for first year at the beginning of the next school year.

Additionally, part of the mission of this school is raising up leaders who walk in honor. As such, we ask that you be diligent in timeliness and check-in, be in your seats, and ready for class by 6:00pm each week. You are strongly encouraged to arrive early in order to access the Transformation Library, check-in, and enjoy fellowship and prayer with one another. If you have not **checked in prior to 6:00pm**, you will be counted as tardy. **Three late arrivals will equate to one full absence.**

Every 4 weeks we will be hosting a viewing of the school's Bible teaching. The Word of God is an essential element of Transformation. Therefore, these teachings are a required component of the curriculum and must be completed, but do not count towards the same attendance policy. Please make every effort to attend these special sessions, but if you are unable, please check out the DVD from the Transformation Library for viewing at home.

In light of the above, I, _____, choose to manage myself and my circumstances in a way to honor my commitment to the school and fellow students. I understand the attendance policy allows me 6 absences. I understand that I am required to view all DVD material presented and agree to check out, watch, and return all missed sessions from the Transformation Library (these DVDs may only be checked out in 1 week intervals).
